About Oakland University

Oakland University was created in 1957, when the late Alfred and Matilda Wilson donated \$2 million and their 1,500-acre estate to Michigan State University to begin a new college in Oakland County.

Named Michigan State University-Oakland, the new campus enrolled its first 570 students in 1959. In 1963, its name changed to Oakland University as the first class graduated with 125 students receiving diplomas. In 1970, the Michigan Legislature recognized the maturity and stature of the University by granting it autonomy, and the governor appointed Oakland University's first Board of Trustees.

From its beginnings, the University has emphasized academic quality, concentrating on providing a dynamic, student-focused learning environment with integration of liberal and professional studies by a faculty of dedicated scholar-teachers. The natural beauty of the campus, much of it still wooded and undeveloped, is enhanced by comprehensive recreational facilities and modern buildings that house the University's many academic and public service programs as well as more than 2,000 residential students.

Dedicated to preparing graduates to make meaningful and substantial contributions to the workplace, society and academia, the University is organized into eight academic units: the College of Arts and Sciences; the schools of Business Administration, Education and Human Services, Engineering and Computer Science, Health Sciences, Medicine, and Nursing; and The Honors College.

Oakland has 146 bachelor degree programs and 134 graduate degree and certificate programs. Doctorates are offered in education with concentrations in educational leadership, counseling and early childhood education; biomedical sciences with specializations in medical physics, health and environmental chemistry, and biological communication; reading education; systems and mechanical engineering; physical therapy; applied mathematical sciences; nursing practice; music education; computer science and informatics; psychology, medicine, and electrical and computer engineering.

The University is continuously adapting to meet the changing needs of students and the marketplace. New programs delivered online and on campus include master's degree programs in nursing, psychology, training and development, public health, software engineering, an Executive MBA program in health care management, and innovative Honors College courses. Business and industry partnerships provide unprecedented opportunities for advanced, hands-on learning.

Now, over 17,000 students attend classes at Oakland University each year, and the number of OU alumni has increased to more than 135,000.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

Ewa Matuszewski

Ewa Matuszewski is the CEO and co-founder of Rochester, Michigan-based MedNetOne Health Solutions (MedNetOne), a health care management/physicians organization offering infrastructure, clinical, and technology services to nearly 1,000 private practice physicians and other independent care providers, including behavioral health specialists. Under her direction, MedNetOne has become a trusted leader in advancing the development and implementation of the Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) and other advanced primary care initiatives involving physicians, their practice teams and myriad community groups and nonprofits.



Throughout her many experiences in leading change, Ms. Matuszewski has promoted a vision of patient-centered health and a culture of organizational excellence, collaboration and transformation. Earlier this year, MedNetOne was the first Michigan physician organization to enter into a joint venture with Nashville-based Honest Medical Group, a physician enablement company aimed at improving the health care experience and reducing costs for members with Medicare Advantage. Under Ms. Matuszewski's direction, MedNetOne recently launched a mobile clinic for community-based care, especially in underserved communities, to offer essential primary care services including chronic illness care, physicals, blood pressure checks and vaccinations.

During the early days of the COVID-19 pandemic, Ms. Matuszewski was in the trenches with her physician members, tracking, providing, and distributing PPE packages and creating a back-to-work playbook and best practices training video that provided steps to safely re-open physician practices and were subsequently adopted for use by a variety of employers and workplaces throughout Michigan. Throughout the pandemic, she has worked with her organization's physician members and partnered with the Detroit Equity Coalition on COVID-19 to vaccinate thousands of individuals, notably those from underserved communities and in Michigan's many diverse ethnic communities.

Ms. Matuszewski is a popular writer and nationally sought-after speaker on multi-disciplinary team-based care, care management strategies, population health, the social determinants of health, palliative care, physician recruitment, incorporating technology into primary care, health policy analysis, Accountable Care Organizations, primary care practice management/government interface and quality improvement and validation within physician practices.

With a keen interest in hands-on-learning and teaching, Ms. Matuszewski is also the founding Principal of the Michigan-based, IACET-accredited Practice Transformation Institute (PTI), which designs, develops and delivers educational programs centered on the 21st century model of medicine to the health care community and medical practice teams.

Ms. Matuszewski is active in civic and professional groups including the Primary Care Collaborative (PCC) where she is an executive member, the BCBSM Stewardship Council, the BCBSM Organized Systems of Care Workgroup, the Polish American Congress, and The Salvation Army Metro Detroit Advisory Board. Locally, Ms. Matuszewski served on the undergraduate population health curriculum development committee at Madonna University and currently serves on the Oakland University School of Health Sciences Board of Advocacy and Resource Development. She attended Wayne State University.

Long lauded for her leadership skills and bold decision-making, Ms. Matuszewski has been named a Crain's Detroit Business Healthcare Hero and a Notable Woman in Healthcare, also by Crain's. She was also named a Champion of the New Economy by DBusiness Magazine.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

Jayprakash 'Jay' Shah

Jay Shah graduated with a Bachelor of Engineering with Distinction from Walchand College of Engineering in India. He received a Masters of Science in Engineering from Wayne State University, and a Masters of Business Administration from University of Detroit. He is a licensed professional engineer.

Shah spent most of his career in civil engineering, eventually becoming Chairman and President of Spalding DeDecker Associates of Rochester Hills, where he helped the firm grow five-fold in stock value and established multiple regional offices. He was also Vice President of Somat Engineering of Detroit, where he successfully diversified its practice and helped it grow regionally and globally.



For his work in the field of engineering, he has been recognized with several awards. Recently Shah was presented the American Council of Engineering Companies/Michigan Leadership Award for a lifetime of outstanding service and significant contribution to the engineering profession. He is also the recipient of the Wayne State University Distinguished Engineering Alumni Achievement Award and is an inductee into the WSU College of Engineering Hall of Fame. He is a Fellow in both the American Council of Engineering Companies and the American Society of Civil Engineers

Shah is President of Jay Shah Associates, a management consulting firm he founded to provide succession planning, strategic direction, and merger and acquisition consulting to Architectural and Engineering companies. He has peer reviewed over sixteen American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) member firms nationwide, providing them the tools to succeed. He mentors the Firm's leadership and key employees.

Shah also founded Leelayan, Inc., a medical device start-up with a mission to provide technology for healthy living. Its first product is a shoe that can be worn hands free and without having to bend, making it easier for compromised people with arthritis, diabetes or back surgery. The shoes operate with a remote control. He designed and developed this unique technology which recently received a patent (U.S. 10,959,486).

Shah was appointed to the Oakland University Board of Trustees by Governor. He served as the Chairman of Facilities Committee and assisted in \$250 Million building projects including the Engineering Center. The Board recognized his services and honored him by designating him as a Trustee Emeritus.

Shah has actively served the community throughout his career that includes numerous charities locally and globally. He is the recipient of national Community Service award from ACEC and Leadership Award from National Multiple Sclerosis Society. He has mentored students at University of Michigan Ross School of Business and Oakland University College of Engineering and the College of Business as well.

Shah continues to encourage his mentees and young people to take leadership roles in the public and private enterprise and in serving their communities. His mantra in life has been to give back and to make a difference.

Jay and his wife Bharti are parents of two grown daughters and grandparents to five amazing kids. Jay recently published his memoir, dedicating it to them and for posterity.

MACE AND PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

In medieval times, a mace was used in warfare. The mace is one of the oldest traditions in academe dating back to the early 1400's when it transitioned from warfare to ceremonial use. Considered a symbol of the University itself, the scepter mace is carried by the University marshal during commencement, convocation and other ceremonial events to signify the arrival of the faculty processional. Oakland's mace, created in 1994, was crafted by jeweler and OU alumnus, Paul Haig and designer Robert Dobbie of P.R. Haig Jewelers in Rochester.

The 30-inch long, approximately 8-pound mace has a white oak handle trimmed with sterling silver ribbon. A black obsidian disk on top is ringed with silver and is inscribed with the University motto. Obsidian is a natural black glass formed by the earth. On each side of the obsidian disk, there is a 14k yellow gold sail. On the base of the handle, a gold oak tree was modeled after a live tree on campus. The clean, straightforward design of the mace reflects the fact that Oakland University is a contemporary institution.

The President's Medallion, also created in 1994 by the same jeweler, is six inches in diameter and reveals the University sail, hangs on a silver chain and is worn by the president at ceremonial events. It is a permanent part of the University's president's academic regalia.

Mission

Oakland University cultivates the full potential of a diverse and inclusive community. As a public doctoral institution, we impact Michigan and the world through education, research, scholarship, and creative activity.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

An edifying note contributed by a certain anonymous doctor of philosophy.

On at least two solemn occasions during the academic calendar — spring and fall commencement — the faculty of the University publicly displays its full academic regalia and participates in the liturgy of processional and recessional, that curious coming and going that symbolizes the ceremony of commencement. The purposes of commencement are well known, but the reasons for the peculiar garb of the celebrants and their odd order of march are often as obscure to the audience as they are, in fact, to the faculty itself. This note may serve to explain academic dress and the professional pecking order it costumes.

Contemporary academics are descendants of clerical schoolmen in the universities of medieval Europe. Like the clergy, members of the bench and bar, and other learned professions, medieval scholars were clothed in

heavy robes to stay warm in unheated stone buildings. Like all members of a hierarchical society, the medieval faculties rejoiced in visible insignia of rank. These outward signs of accomplishment and authority were tailored into robes. Although the need for such voluminous garments to keep the scholar from freezing is long past, the use of them as emblems of dignity remains. You will observe that all caps and gowns worn by our faculty are black, with certain exceptions. Black was the color adopted by mutual agreement among American universities at the end of the 19th century. In Europe, each University has its own distinctive gown, varying in color and cut from all others.

There are three basic academic degrees: the baccalaureate or bachelor's degree, the master's degree, and the doctorate. A special style of robe is prescribed for each. The bachelor's gown is sparsely cut, neat, but a bit skimpy and unadorned, as befits apprentices. The master's gown is still simple, but fuller, sports a sleeve of extraordinary design impossible to describe, and has a hood draped from the shoulders down the back. Once used to keep the frost from the tonsured heads of medieval clerks, the hood is solely a badge of a degree of scholarly achievement. The master's hood is small and narrow, but displays the colors of the institution that awarded the degree. If you knew the colors of American universities, you could easily identify whence came our masters. The doctoral robe is the most handsome of academic raiment. Generous of cut, of fine aristocratic stuff, it is faced with velvet chevrons on the ample sleeves. You will note that most of the velvet facings and chevrons are black, but that some are of other colors. According to personal taste, the doctor may display the color of his or her doctoral degree on the sleeves and facings: light blue for education, pink for music, apricot for nursing, orange for engineering, and many more. The royal blue of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) is the most commonly seen in liberal arts institutions such as Oakland. The doctor's hood is the most elegant of all





academic appurtenances. Large and graceful, it is lined in satin with the colors of the University that awarded the degree and is bordered with the color of the degree itself. Most academic costumes include the square cap called a mortarboard; the doctor's tassel may be either black or gold — tassels of all other degrees are black and stringy.

To instructed eyes, the order of march in the processional and recessional reveals the standing of individuals in the institution's formal hierarchy. In the processional, the order of entrance into the hall is, quite fittingly, from most junior to most senior. The baccalaureate candidates enter first, followed successively by the masters and doctoral candidates with the whole separated from the faculty by a decent interval. In the faculty order, the instructors precede the assistant professors that in turn are followed by the associate professors. The august full professors bring up the rear. After a respectful distance come the deans who in turn are separated by a significant space from the awful majesty of the platform party, the vice president, the president, and the members of the board of trustees.

All remain standing until the board is seated. After the ceremony, the order of recessional is the reverse of the processional. The greatest dignitaries stream out first, with the artfully organized ranks of priority wallowing in their wake.

It is hoped that these notes may make more intelligible the spectacle you are witnessing today. A discerning intelligence may detect in it many clues to an understanding of the academic profession as it confronts the ambiguities of the future with ancient wisdom and dignified confidence.
