APPROVAL OF HONORARY DEGREE FOR A.P.J. ABDUL KALAM A Recommendation

- 1. Division and Department: Academic Affairs
- 2. <u>Introduction</u>: In accordance with Article IX of the Bylaws of the Board of Trustees, honorary degrees may be awarded by the Board of Trustees in recognition of distinguished accomplishment and service within the scope of the arts and letters, sciences, professions, and public service as recognized and supported by the University. The awarding of honorary degrees reaffirms Oakland University's scholarly, creative, and humanitarian values and ties the University to the community at large.

Oakland University wishes to recognize Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam as a distinguished individual for his achievements as former president of India (2002-2007), his significant contributions as a scientist and engineer, and his visionary focus on the future of India and the world. Prior to his tenure as president, Dr. Kalam's groundbreaking work as an aeronautical engineer led to his leadership in the development of India's first satellite launch vehicle in orbit, and the subsequent development of the nation's guided missile program. He held important posts in the government, including the rank of Cabinet Minister, serving as principal scientific advisor to the country. In addition, Dr. Kalam created a plan for India titled "Technology Vision 2020," described as a road map for transforming the country through an emphasis on technological and economic growth. During and after his presidency he has remained committed to leading India forward through science and technology. His views on India's future as a knowledge superpower have been expressed through his teaching and research, and he currently holds the position of Professor of Technology and Societal Transformation at Anna University at Chennai. Among his several books are Wings of Fire (1999); India 2020: A Vision for the New Millennium (2003); Scientist to President (2003); Ignited Minds: Unleashing the Power Within India (2003); and India-my-dream (2004). Known as the "People's President" during his term of service, Dr. Kalam has been honored with India's highest civilian awards - Padma Bhushan (1981), Padma Vibhushan (1990), and Bharat Ratna, the "Jewel of India" in (1997).

- **3.** <u>Previous Board Action</u>: The Board of Trustees periodically awards honorary degrees at its Formal Sessions.
