If necessary, a committee can reexamine a proposal that has been substantively changed since its approval.

Table 3 tracks the Registrar's assignment of a rubric, the Provost's, the Steering Committee's, and the Senate's disposition of the program, as well as final approvals of the Provost's group and the Board of Trustees.
