APPROVAL OF EQUIPMENT INSTALLMENT PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR GOLF CARS

A Recommendation

Introduction

The term of Oakland University's current Equipment Lease Agreement for 140 electric Club Car golf cars with Associates Leasing, Inc. expired on October 31, 2004. The University issued a request for proposal for a new lease and/or purchase agreement to include: pricing for 120 electric golf cars; a five-year term; if a lease, an option to purchase the golf cars at the end of the term; and recommendations for financing options. Proposals were solicited from the three major manufacturers of golf cars, Club Car, E-Z Go and Yamaha. The University received two proposals from Club Car and E-Z Go.

The Club Car purchase proposal is recommended. The vehicle has many advantages including a 48 volt four battery system with a five year warranty, programmable fleet management features, aluminum frame, and local service. The purchase option allows Oakland University the flexibility to own and/or manage the useful life of the fleet for future years of use or trade-in value.

Recommendation

WHEREAS, the Golf and Learning Center requires a new golf car fleet to replace the fleet leased under an agreement that expired on October 31, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, the University administration believes it prudent to accept the proposal from Club Car to enter into a five-year Equipment Installment Purchase Agreement at a total five-year cost of \$449,532, plus applicable sales taxes; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the President is authorized to enter into a five-year Equipment Installment Purchase Agreement to purchase 120 electric Club Car golf cars commencing in 2005; and, be it further
